Programmatic Changes

Beginning Jan. 1, incentives will be increased for the following measures. All applications received after Jan. 1, 2019 will qualify for these incentives:

Multiple Measure Bonuses:

Gold Savings Bonus	Perform 5 measures	\$350 gas/combo
Platinum Savings Bonus	Perform 6 measures	\$500 gas/combo
Whole House Improvements	Perform 7+ measures	\$700 gas/combo

Equipment Measure Additions:

97% AFUE or higher Furnace	\$500 gas/combo
17-19.99 SEER AC	\$500 electric/combo
20+ SEER AC	\$600 electric/combo

Rebates will no longer be available for: Non Wi-Fi enabled Programmable Thermostats, Air Source Heat Pumps, and Ground Source Heat Pumps.



Effective Jan. 1, 2019, all new rebate submissions **must** use 2019 application materials.
