

For Insulation:

- Square footage of roof attic, above-grade wall, basement or crawlspace. Measure and multiply the length and width of the installation. See the Square Ft. Calculation example to the right. (For rim joist, measure and add the length and width to get lineal feet.) Please ensure the square footage appears on your invoice to prevent delays in processing your rebate.
- □ R-value of insulation installed. R-value is a measure of resistance to heat flow through a given thickness of a material. If the R-value is not known, please indicate how many inches and what type of insulation was installed.

Funds for incentives are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Incentive amounts are valid through December 31, 2017, but can change without notice. 
PROOF OF PURCHASE:

- Receipt Requirements: Must show product name, quantity, place, cost and date of purchase. Return receipts are not valid as proof of purchase.
- Invoice Requirements: Must include customer name, account service location (where work was performed), date of installation, cost and the following:
- Windows/Doors—Product description and quantity
- \cdot Insulation—Detailed scope of work indicating type of material installed and quantity or square footage for area installed. See the Square Ft. Calculation example, above right.
- ADDITIONAL WINDOWS/DOORS REQUIREMENTS: Must have a National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) sticker with a U-factor of 0.27 or less for windows and 0.30 or less for doors or be rated as ENERGY STAR for Northern Climate Zone OR must include the manufacturer product literature or specification sheet indicating that the product has a U-factor of 0.27 or less for windows or 0.30 or less for doors.
